1.6 CONTROL MEASURES

- To reduce infestations and prevent spread Spiny burrgrass to be treated before seed set.
- Treat Spiny burrgrass with a registered herbicide in the manner according to label
- Cultivation may be used as a form of control
- Remove all spiny burrgrass from recognised waterways and within 50 metres of a property boundary.
- A council approved property control plan may be developed providing more specific control measures.

LAND HOLDERS OBLIGATION:

Section 12 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 states private occupiers of land must control noxious weeds on their land. An occupier (other than a public authority or a local control authority) of to which a weed control order applies must control noxious weeds on the land as required under the order.

Note: If an occupier fails to comply with their obligations under the weed control order these may be enforce against the owner of the land as well as the occupier by a weed control notice issued under Section 18 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993.
