### 1.6 CONTROL MEASURES

- To prevent spread of St Johns Wort plants must be treated before seed set.
- Treat with an herbicide that is registered for the control of St Johns Wort in the manner according to the label.
- All St Johns Wort to be removed from all recognised water ways and 50 metres from property boundaries.
- A council approved property management control plan may be developed to provide more specific control measure.

# LAND HOLDERS OBLIGATION:

Section 12 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 states private occupiers of land must control noxious weeds on their land. An occupier (other than a public authority or a local control authority) of to which a weed control order applies must control noxious weeds on the land as required under the order.

**Note**: If an occupier fails to comply with their obligations under the weed control order these may be enforce against the owner of the land as well as the occupier by a weed control notice issued under Section 18 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993.
