

# COUNCIL COLUMN – WEDNESDAY 19 AUGUST 2020 COUNCIL MEETING

The next Ordinary Council meeting will be held Wednesday, 9 September, at Council's Chambers, commencing at 5.30 pm.

Following the lifting of the COVID-19 Restrictions, Council has resumed meeting in the Chambers with a maximum of four (4) members of the public in attendance. The meetings will no longer be live streamed, however an audio recording will uploaded the following day.

### PUBLIC EXHIBITION - RIVERSIDE PRECINCT CONCEPT PLAN

Council resolved at its monthly meeting held on 12 August 2020 to place the Riverside Precinct Concept Plan on public Exhibition. In August 2018, the Sport and Recreational Services Master Plan 2018 was adopted by Council. An action within the Master Plan is to develop a Riverside Precinct Plan.

Council engaged Somewhere Landscape Architecture firm to develop a design for the Riverside precinct (Precinct Concept Plan can be found on the link below). This precinct includes all public open space bordering the Macquarie river and Culling Street, including Rotary Park, Rotary Gully, Noel Powell Ovals and Olsen Oval.
