**NARROMINE AND TRANGIE POOLS**

Narromine and Trangie pools will close for the season at 6:00pm, Friday 29th March. The closure is required to start demolition and refurbishment works at both pools to ensure a timely opening for the 2019/20 summer season. Should any clubs or coaches wish to apply for use past this date, a booking request will be required and assessed on a case by case basis.

It is expected that the children's pool at the Narromine pool will be out of use for the start of the 2019/20 summer season due to the construction of the new splash pad and learn to swim pool. Further information will be provided on the timing of the opening after confirmation of the construction schedule.
