#### 1. TRANGIE TRUCK STOP SIGNAGE

#### **Executive Summary**

The purpose of this report is to provide the Local Traffic Committee with information regarding change of signage for the Trangie Truck Area.

#### Report

The Trangie Truck Area was initially designed for B-Double vehicle access, as per grant submission and subsequent approval. Council was approached and asked if a larger type vehicle could access the truck facility. Council resolved at its February 2020 ordinary meeting (Res no. 2020/022) that this matter be further investigated to determine if a 47.5m Common Type 2 Road Train – Class 2 B- Triple could access and exit the truck stop. Upon review of the turning movements in the area it was determined that vehicles up to a 53.5m (A-Double) could enter and exit the truck stop (attachment No.1). However, it seems as if the design vehicle crosses the centre line in Dandaloo Street when turning into Dandaloo Street. A survey of the exit blister will be conducted this week to confirm 53m vehicles can exit the truck stop safely. It is therefore proposed to allow vehicles of size up to A-Double (53.5m) to access the site subject to the outcome of the survey investigation. This will also require the changing of signage arrangement for the site, once approved (attachment No.2).

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

That approval be granted to increase the vehicle dimension to a 53.5m (A-Double) subject to the outcome of the survey investigation of the exit blister.

Council has received a request from a local bus company (provided to the committee under separate cover) to erect signs near the Gin Gin Bridge on the Collie Road Trangie.


As the letter states, the bus stops at the Bridge and there is concern for safety with the volume and speed of heavy vehicles.


#### **RECOMMENDATION**
