Executive Summary

Largely the support would be a contribution towards some of the ground keeping works undertaken as well as financial relief for the water usage.

Turf Club Executive have outlined that this work is undertaken by the Turf Club for the benefit of the whole Community and as such a greater contribution from the community is warranted.

Financial Implications
