Trangie Cemetery	 General maintenance, mowing and weed spraying. Topping up of subsiding graves continues. Dead trees are noted and plan for renewal will be put in place when water availability improves.
WATER AND SEWER	
Tomingley	 Continued regular system maintenance at the water treatment plant. Staff have completed quarterly meter reading.
Trangie	 Staff have continued reticulation system maintenance. Contractors have completed quarterly meter reading. Staff have been involved in Data collection via GPS for creation of a new hydraulic model. Staff have dealt with numerous sewer pump station blockages and mains chokes due to non-biodegradable materials being used in the sewer systems.
Narromine	 Drilling of the next deep stage of Bore 8 has been completed and developed. The 72 hour yield and draw down test has been carried out and we are awaiting chemical, biological and radiological test results to be returned. The Iron and Manganese removal plant will commence construction on April 2 with arrival of the site project manager and set up of site amenities and storage tanks. Telemetry contractors have completed installation of control equipment hardware. A considerable amount of associated works have been completed. Contractors have completed quarterly meter reading. Regular Drinking Water Quality sampling and analysis continues along with extra sampling involved with new bore connections and system upgrading activities.




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WATER AND SEWER CONT.	
Narromine	 Localised dead-end flushing has been carried out to maintain water quality. Sewer pump station maintenance is ongoing and has increased in frequency due to problems with non-biodegradable materials being used by consumers as a substitute for toilet paper. Staff have continued sewer collection system maintenance with an increase in blockage frequency being noted.
