Welcome to the Narromine Shire, situated in the heart of the rich Macquarie Valley in central west New South Wales.

We are a Shire that is continuing to develop, prosper and grow towards its full potential.

Agriculture has long been a mainstay, and Narromine Shire is known for its sheep, cattle and wool production as well as broadacre cereal crops. Cotton production has become increasingly important in recent years. Major commercial nurseries and research facilities at Narromine support the national forestry and vegetable industries and Trangie Research Centre is one of the largest broadacre agricultural research centres in Australia. Significant mineral resources have been discovered near Tomingley in the south of the Shire with Alkane Resources Limited providing significant employment opportunities.

In order, to take advantage of the strong agribusiness in the Shire, our transport links, closeness to Dubbo and the emergence of mining, Council is working collaboratively with other stakeholders to attract industry, generate jobs and grow our population.

The potential for development is high as reflected by recent interest in industrial and residential land, the expansion of the Skypark residential estate and the Narromine Aerodrome Industrial Park.

The proposed Inland Rail route will come through our Shire close to Narromine providing further economic opportunities in the future.

Narromine Shire's close proximity to Dubbo Airport ensures that the business sector and residents maintain strong links to Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Newcastle and Canberra.

Many long term local businesses, along with those who have more recently made the move to the region, are enjoying the benefits of working in the Narromine area. They realise that business can be equally, if not more successful in a regional setting, and are tapping into a skilled and

experienced local workforce, engaging locally-based support services, part of a strong community and doing all of this just a short flight from capital and regional cities.

The Shire covers 5,200ha2 or 1.3million acres and has access to both riparian and underground water sources. We have approximately 800,000 tonnes of grain storage in the Shire, making it an ideal location for intensive animal production and with the transport links you can send produce easily to every mainland capital.


INTRODUCTION

Agriculture is the most signicant industry for the Narromine Shire . It is the Shire's largest employer, largest generator of output and value-add and Narromine's largest exporting industry to outside markets . Some of Narromine's most prevalent commodities include wheat, cotton, chickpeas, and cattle with many other commodities contributing signicantly to the local economy .

Located six hour's drive from Sydney and 34 minutes from Dubbo City, Narromine is a Shire with a population of 6,599 persons .

Narromine's Agricultural sector generates \$210 .735 million in output and contributes 10.6% to total Agricultural output for the Orana Region .

Narromine and Orana Region Map




Narromine Agriculture Sector at a glance:

- The region's largest number of businesses, 509 in (June 2016).
- The largest regional industry sector output of \$210.735 million, which is 27.0% of Narromine total output.
- Largest employing sector in the region with 710 jobs, 30.4% of Narromine total employment.
- The largest value of exports, at \$170.828 million, accounting for 45.5% of total regional exports.
- The highest industry value-add by sector, with \$82.480 million, or 24.0% of total regional value-added.
- The largest sector in terms of local supply chains, with the Agriculture sector purchasing \$65.531 million from other businesses in Narromine .

BUSINESS COUNTS 2016

The 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' sector is the largest industry sector in terms of business counts with 509 businesses or 53.4% of the Shire's businesses.




EMPLOYMENT

The average business in Narromine generates \$817,800 in output for the Shire. Agricultural businesses contribute approximately \$414,000 in output per business.

Employment 2016

There are a total of 2,300 jobs within Narromine as at the 2016 Census, of which 712 are in the 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' industry sector, making it the largest employing sector in the region. The next largest regional employer is the 'Education & Training' industry sector, with 239 jobs, followed by 'Health Care & Social Assistance' with 215 jobs.



AGRICULTURE INDUSTRY SECTOR, 2016


The 712 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' jobs, account for 30.4% of the total regional workforce. Narromine's 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' sector contributes 10.6% of total Orana Region and 0.9% of total New South Wales 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' jobs.

The industry sub-sector 'Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing Support Services' account for 3.7% of total jobs in Narromine, signicantly higher than the 1.2% for the broader Orana Region.

Regional Exports 2016


The 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' sector in the Narromine Shire exports approximately \$170.83 million (or 45.5% of total regional exports).





Agriculture Sub-Sectors Regional Exports, 2016


The 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' sector can be further drilled down to sub-sectors to provide a more detailed understanding of local agricultural economic activity in Narromine . The majority of exports from the region are from sub-sector 'Sheep, Grains, Beef & Diary Cattle' sector (38.0% of total regional exports) .



Contribution to Gross Regional Product, 2017

The 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' sector recorded industry value-added (or contribution to Gross Regional Product) of \$82.480 million in the Narromine Shire for 2017, or 24.0% of total value-added for the region (total value-added for Narromine is \$344.019 million).


Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing is the largest industry contributor to GRP in 2017 ahead of 'Rental, Hiring & Real Estate Services' (\$50.971 million) and 'Mining' (\$50.465 million) .



TURNOVER AND WORKFORCE SIZE

Almost one-quarter of 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' businesses in the Narromine Shire have an annual turnover between \$500,000 and \$2 million (24.8%), followed by those businesses with a turnover between \$200,000 and \$500,000 (24.6%)

Average employment per business in the 'Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing' industry sector in Narromine Shire is 1.4 jobs which is below the average workforce size for all industries sectors in the Shire (2.5 jobs).

Gross Value of Production, 2015-16

The dominant agricultural commodity in Narromine in 2015 -16 was Crops, producing a gross value of \$149.0 million and more than three quarters (77.1%) to total agricultural gross value for the region. Livestock (products and slaughtered) were valued at \$40.7 million or 21.1% of total gross value of agricultural commodity production.


ACTIVITY BY COMMODITY

Cereal Crops


The total area for cereal crops for all purposes in the Narromine Shire for 2015 -16 was 144,240 hectares (15.8% of the land allocated to cereal crop production in Orana Region). A total of 289,027 tonnes of cereal crops were produced in the Shire. This is equal to an average yield rate of 2.1 tonnes per hectare in Narromine Shire. This is greater than the yield rate for Orana Region (1.8 tonnes per hectare).

The total value of cereal crops within Narromine Shire in 2015-16 was \$78.5 million which was dominated by wheat production at \$63.9 million (81.8% contribution to total cereal crop value). The value of Narromine cereal crops accounted for 18.2%

Non-Cereal Crops


A total of 61,482 tonnes of non -cereal crops was produced in Narromine Shire. This is equal to an average yield rate of 1.5 tonnes per hectare. This is marginally

less than the average yield rate for the wider Orana Region (1.5 tonnes per hectare). The total area of non - cereal crops for all purposes in Narromine Shire for 2015 -16 was 61,482 hectares (12.4% of the 337,630 hectares allocated to non -cereal crop production in the wider Orana Region).


The total value of non -cereal crops within Narromine Shire in 2015 -16 was \$70.5 million in which the largest contributions were made from cotton production at \$33.8 million (47.9%) and chickpea production at \$16.7 million (23.7%). The value of Narromine non -cereal crops dened 19.2% of Orana Region non -cereal crops.

Broadacre Crops, Narromine Gross Value 2015-16



Livestock


Beehives number in excess of 1,050 and account for 34.9% of all beehives in Orana. The most prominent livestock in Narromine is sheep and lambs, with the number of lambs in Narromine accounting for 8.1% of all lambs in the Orana Region.

The gross value of livestock slaughtered for 2015 -16 was \$27.9 million, consisting of \$18.3 million in cattle and calves, \$9.4 million in sheep and lambs and \$0.1 million in pig slaughters.

Proportion of Orana Region Gross Value – Livestock Slaughtered, 2015-16




Gross Value of Livestock Slaughtered, Narromine, 2015-16




The gross value of livestock products in Narromine for 2015-16 is \$12.8 million which is driven by \$12.4 million in wool sales and \$0.4 million in milk sales. Narromine's livestock products accounted for 6.6% of the gross value generated by Orana Region in livestock products for 2015-16.



Horticulture


Narromine's Horticulture sector includes nurseries and the production of citrus and grapes for wine production. The total value of Narromine's horticultural sector is \$3.5 million where the largest contributing commodity is oranges valued at \$1.2 million (33.5%) followed by lemons (\$1.1 million or 30.2% of horticultural activity).

Production and gross value for the Orana region's nursery production, and oranges and lemons is predominately from Narromine. Grapes for wine production are now producing and have contributed 2.5% to total Orana region gross value for grapes for wine production.
