State of the Environment Report 2015 - 2016





State of the Environment

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A State of the Environment (SoE) Report is an important management tool which aims to provide the community and Local Council with information on the condition of the environment in the local area to assist in decision-making.

Since 2007, the Councils of the Greater Central West Region of NSW (see map) have joined to produce Regional SoE Reports as part of Council reporting requirements.

Changes to NSW legislation mean that Councils are no longer required to produce SoE Reports each year, but only once every four years, in the year of the Council election (this year for some Councils). However, the participating Councils have decided to continue reporting on an annual basis so that they can provide a detailed Regional SoE report this year that covers trends in the intervening years.

This is a brief snapshot of data for the Narromine Local Government Area in 2015-16 across a range of environmental indicators as shown in the tables below. The tables provide an understanding of trends by comparing this year's data with an average of previous years. The Council snapshot report should be read in conjunction with the 2015-16 Regional SoE report.

2014-15 Highlights

- Town water use was lower than the average use over the previous three reporting periods.
- There were fewer native fish restocked into local waterways that in the previous three years.
- Council's annual electricity consumption for its facilities declined from last year.
- The uptake of small scale renewable energy was at its highest level in the past four years.
- Council's total operational greenhouse gas emissions were at their highest level in the past four years.
- There was a substantial increase in the amount of hazardous chemicals disposed of correctly.
