2. Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council

- The draft Funding Case to Establish a Regional Local Government Water Training Centre in the Orana Region was presented and discussed. It was resolved that the Board approach high levels of State and Federal governments to access funding.
- Leo Krikmann from United Way delivered a presentation in relation to the Dolly Parton Imagination Library Program.
- The Hon Jenny Aitchison MP, the Minister for Regional Transport and Roads attended the meeting. Minister Aitchison provided an overview of her portfolio and spent time with each of the Mayors and General Managers.
- Allistair Lunn, Regional Director West, Transport for NSW (TfNSW) also provided an update noting the following:
 - The state of the roads, following natural disasters in recent years, remains the biggest challenge at present with 2,500 Kilometres of damage to the State Road network.
 - RMCC remains an integral part of maintenance of the State Road network and TfNSW values the relationship they have with Councils.
- Brendan Guiney, Executive Officer, NSW Water Directorate discussed Water Security for Regional NSW. NSW Water has been working closely with Local Government and more recently the Country Mayors Association on this issue.
