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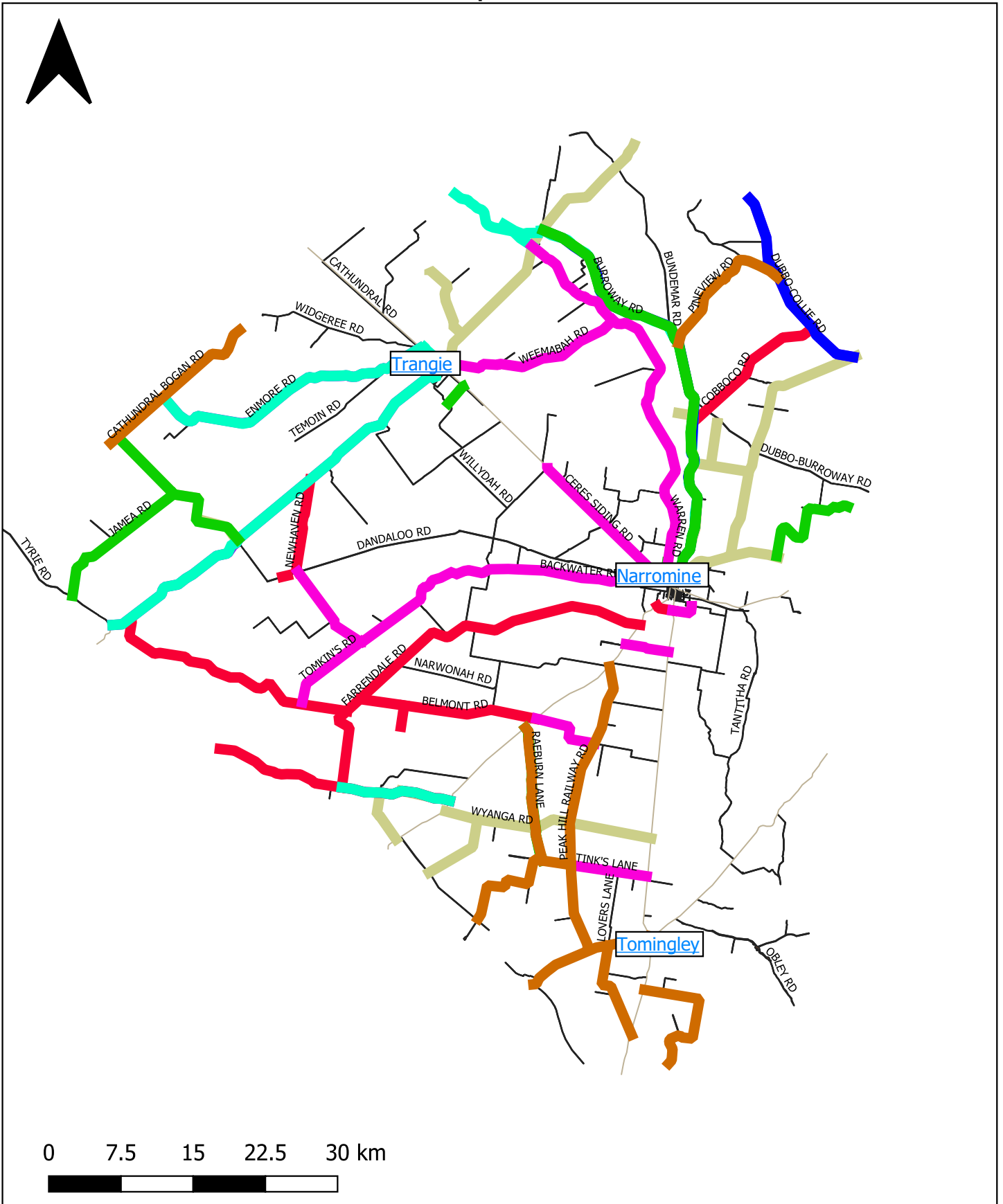

Trangie Cemetery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General maintenance, mowing and weed spraying. • Topping up of subsiding graves continues. • Dead trees are noted and renewal/replacement plan will be put in place when water availability improves.
WATER AND SEWER	
Tomingley	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continued regular system maintenance at the water treatment plant.
Trangie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff have continued reticulation system maintenance. • Staff continue to deal with sewer pump station blockages and mains chokes due to non-biodegradable materials being used in the sewer systems. • Specialist contractors have carried out a dive inspection and cleaning of the water reservoir floor.
Narromine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contractors have commenced construction of the Iron and Manganese removal plant at the town bore 6 site. Dry Commissioning will commence Tuesday 5 May 2020 with Wet Commissioning to follow. Batch testing is scheduled for the 14 May 2020 immediately followed by proving, which will run for around 5 weeks. • Specialist contractors have carried out a dive inspection and cleaning of the reservoir floors in both Duffy and Nymagee Streets drinking water reservoirs to remove deposits. Staff carried out systematic reticulation flushing to remove deposits and ensure continued water quality. • Staff have commenced mains replacement in Meryula Street between Meringo and Culling Streets. • Regular Drinking Water Quality sampling and analysis continues, along with extra sampling involved with new bore connections and system upgrading activities. • Sewer pump station maintenance is ongoing and has increased in frequency due to problems with non-biodegradable materials being used by consumers as a substitute for toilet paper. • Staff have continued sewer collection system maintenance with an increase in blockage frequency being noted.

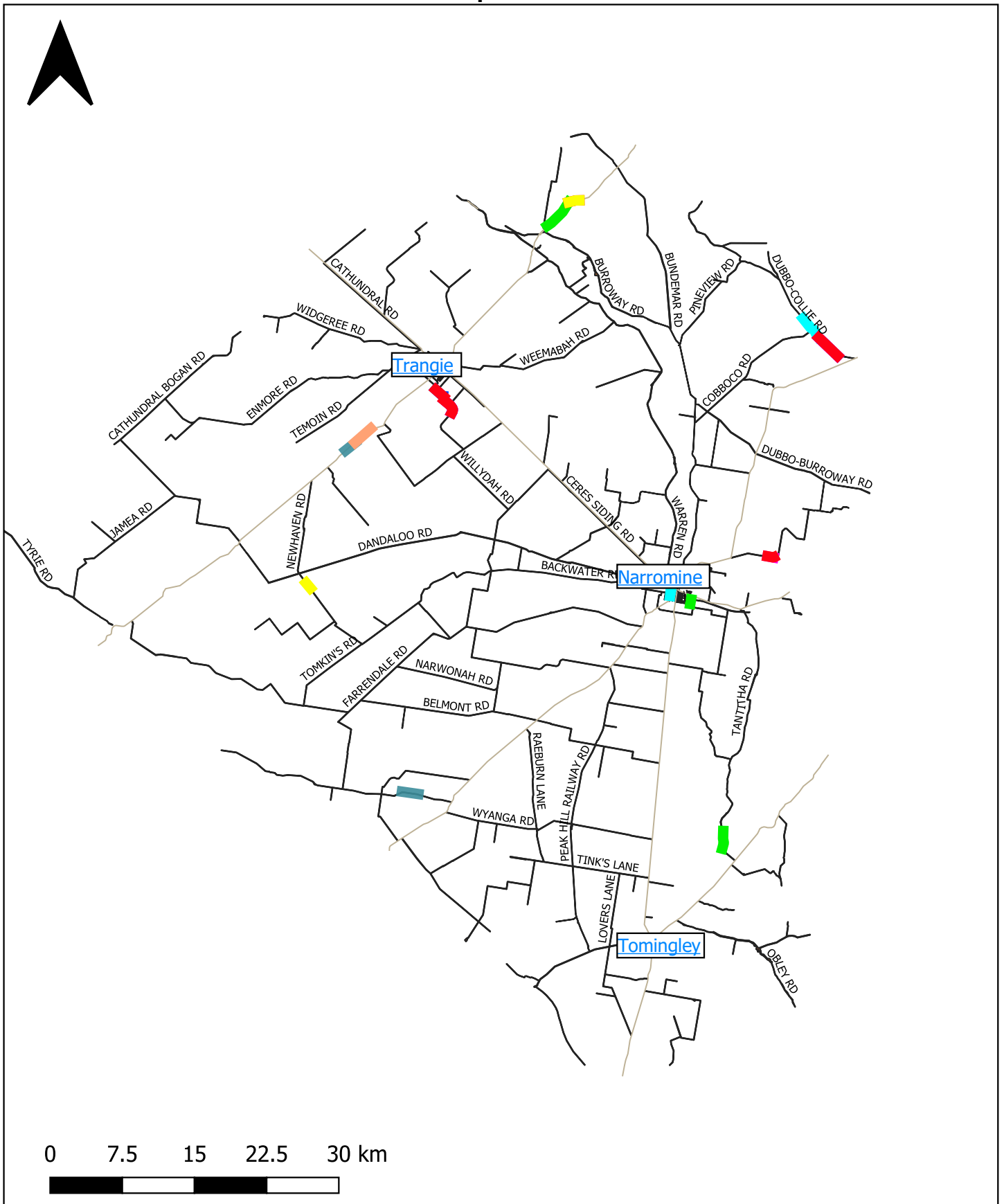
