1. **Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting**

2. **Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council**

- A) **Christmas Party:** Due to the uncertainty around COVID19 restrictions, those present felt too uncertain to be able to organize a large Christmas event.
