1. **Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting**

Quarterly Committee Meeting

2. **Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council**

- The Sappa Bulga & Momo area fire trails are too wet still to assess management works required to bring them up to standard.
- The BRIMS portal closes on Friday, 25 June 2021. Its replacement "GUARDIAN" opens on 1 July 2021. Updating any works proposed or completed in GUARDIAN is not only good for reporting purposes but also for future funding and proof of works in the event of a fire impacting the area.
- Training for GUARDIAN commences 28 June 2021 onwards.
- Acting Executive Officer of Orana NSW Rural Fire Service is to update NSC proposed works schedule from BRIMS onto GUARDIAN on NSC behalf while NSC staff are trained in its use.
- NSC are advised to contact the Manager Community Risk – Area Western NSW at NSW Fire Service, regarding any proposed new hazard reduction (HR) works before going through the application process. Tim advised there may be other funding opportunities available for different HR works (apart from roadside slashing) in addition to outside bodies qualifying to carry out the works on Council behalf.

3. **Benefits to Narromine Shire Council**

Provides a direct avenue of communication between Council and the Orana Fire Control and other agencies to discuss and plan fire prevention activities, programs, and issues around the Orana region.

4. **Suggestions for Future Action (if appropriate)**

Continued attendance at BFMC meetings and continued close liaison with the regional fire control agencies.
