3. NSW COUNTRY MAYORS ASSOCIATION EXECUTIVE

The Country Mayors Association of NSW (CMA) has announced their new executive team at the AGM held on Friday 11 March 2022. The Mayor of Parkes has returned as Chair, and the Mayor of Gunnedah has been elected as Deputy Chair.

Eight Country Mayors were also elected to the Executive, including myself as Mayor of Narromine Shire Council, Cr Rick Firman OAM (Temora), Cr Russel Fitzpatrick (Bega Valley), Cr John Medcalf OAM (Lachlan), Cr Phyllis Mill OAM (Forbes), Cr Sue Moore (Singleton), Cr Kylie Thomas (Kyogle) and Cr Russell Webb (Tamworth). The General Manager of Parks Shire Council, Mr Kent Boyd, was elected Secretary/Public Officer.

Priority areas for the CMA include working with the State Government advocating for health services in the regions, ensuring towns have sustainable water supplies and ensuring the financial sustainability of Local Government. A whole of government approach to disaster planning, skills and education and regional housing is also to be prioritised.

Each Mayor is given a specific role to undertake. I am to research the state of water security across Western NSW and will be addressing the Lower Water Utilities Alliance meeting on 21 April 2022.

The executive meetings are held quarterly prior to the Country Mayors Association meetings. They are generally held in Parliament House.
