### **Executive Summary**

The purpose of this report is to provide information with regards to the future of the Narromine Saleyards.

---

### **Report**

The Narromine Saleyards has not been used for a number of years and the current operator has indicated that they will not be in position to continue with future operations/leases with Council.

It is therefore timely, that Council consider the future use of the Narromine Saleyards and it is recommended that a consultation process is followed with the broader community to identify potential future uses. The Narromine Catchment Survey and Analyses (Stormwater Drainage Study Report) previously indicated that this area could be used for future stormwater management or treatment. While this is still a potential, proper analyses would be required to determine the feasibility of any future use.




