Country Mayors Association Meeting and AGM

1. Main Purpose of Conference/Visit/Meeting

To collaborate and co-operate with all Country Councils in NSW

2. Key Messages/Highlights of Relevance to Council

Delegates elected to the Executive for the 2022/23 and 2023/24 years. Meeting dates for 2023 are 10 March, 26 May, 4 August and 3 November.

Port of Newcastle CEO addressed the Mayors and General Managers about the new legislation awaiting the Governor's assent that will enable his company the opportunity to be a container port and compete with both Port of Botany and Port Kembla. Under a previous agreement of sale, the PON was prohibited from the container trade past 30,000 containers per annum.

Minister for Local Government advised that approaches are being made to the Commonwealth Government for assistance with rural roads emergency funding. Legislation has passed for a Reconstruction Authority and there has been a focus on sustainability and input into the IPART rate increase. The Emergency Services Levy will need to be increased.

3. Benefits to Narromine Shire Council

Keeping us abreast of developments that will have a significant impact on investment and job creation in the Shire as a result of our Freight Hub and involvement in Inland Rail.

Collaboration and opportunities to discuss issues pertaining to rural and regional Councils.
