Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with information on the available options for Public Facilities for Dundas Park in Narromine.

Report

A report has been prepared on the feasibility of installing an additional toilet facility in Dundas Park or to use the existing facility at Dundas Oval in accordance with the Notice of Motion adopted at the February 2022 Council Meeting.

Background

Existing facility – Burroway Street – adjacent to Narromine Aquatic Centre

The existing toilet facilities at the Narromine Aquatic Centre which service Dundas Park are located approximately 146m from the new play equipment. These facilities were recently refurbished in 2020 and provide adequate road side parking for the travelling public directly in front of the facility, and the provision of disabled facilities.

Soccer club toilets – adjacent to north eastern end of Narromine Aquatic Centre and adjacent to Dundas Oval

The soccer club toilets were refurbished at least ten years ago and are predominately only used by sporting groups for weekend sport. They remain locked unless they are open for a sporting event. The clubs have identified that they are no longer fit for purpose and have requested assistance with a new or upgraded facility that will service all sporting clubs needs.

2. PROPOSED NEW PUBLIC FACILITY IN DUNDAS PARK NARROMINE (Cont'd)

Dundas Park

Dundas Park is a focal point for the community with many activities and amenities within the park and is prone to flooding during major rain events.

Concerns have been raised by community members about the distance of the facilities at the front of the Narromine Aquatic Centre to the new playground area, and safety concerns with young children.

Options

Option 1: Leave as status quo, the existing toilets at the Narromine Aquatic Centre were refurbished in 2020 and have parking, a pedestrian refuge and dedicated disabled parking available.

Option 2: Refurbish or rebuild the Toilets at Dundas Oval and make available to the public, whilst maintaining the toilets at the front of the Aquatic Centre.

These toilets will need to undergo extensive upgrading to bring them up to accessible standard for the general public, there will also need to be a new footpath and signage installed to link the toilets to the park. The location of these existing toilets is away from the road so therefore will create an ongoing problem with lack of use and vandalism due to infrastructure concealment which goes against vandalism or antisocial behaviour minimisation principles.

Option 3: Build a new facility in the vicinity of Dundas Park, and close and demolish the Soccer Club facilities. This option places the facility within easy walking distance from the park amenities and continues to service Dundas Oval. The location of this option is restricted by the existing flooding problems within Dundas Park.

Legal and Regulatory Compliance

Risk Management Issues

Dundas Park is prone to flooding.

Location of the facility is to be determined with the need to minimise the possibility of vandalism by having the facility close to a road and within visual distance of the users.

Consideration must be given regarding the future use of the Dundas Park Precinct in consultation with users.




