Note from General Manager: -

Council's Crime Minimisation Strategy includes the following action: -

• Identify Hotspots and provide surveillance – Mobile CCTV unit and enhanced CCTV capability across the CBD and access roads to Narromine.

The action is ongoing and is to be made in consultation with the NSW Police.

Council's Draft Delivery Program (2022/2023 – 2026/2027) includes the following action: -

 Investigate installing further CCTV cameras in CBD and appropriate avenues of grant funding

• Grant funding has been received for Trangie CCTV and Narromine CCTV (total of \$193,000).

If Council is to make provision for funding within the 2022/23 budget a source of funding will need to be identified.
