## **CONTRACTING TO COUNCIL - HOW TO REGISTER**

All contractors who are engaged by Council are required to register with Council's Contractor Management System, **Vault**, before commencing any work. ## RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP – COUNCIL'S ANIMAL SHELTER

All pet owners are reminded that Narromine Shire Council's animal shelter does not have set opening hours therefore, to access the Animal Shelter please call Council on 02 6889 9999 to organise a suitable time. The Animal Shelter is under 24hr recorded video surveillance. To arrange the release of an impounded animal from the Narromine Animal Shelter you will need to make an appointment with a Ranger on 02 6889 9999. Please note that Council does not release companion animals after hours.

Please note that all impounded animals must be microchipped and registered before being released from the pound. You will need to provide suitable personal identification such as a driver's licence, and any other appropriate documentation for your animal e.g. sterilisation certificate or microchipping form.
