### **EXTENDED SCHOOL HOLIDAY HOURS AT NARROMINE AND TRANGIE AQUATIC CENTRES**

Please be advised that Narromine and Trangie Aquatic Centres will have extended pool hours during the 2020/2021 Summer school holiday period effective from 21 December 2020 through to 29 January 2021.

During this time, the opening hours at **Narromine Aquatic Centre** will be

The opening hours at **Trangie Aquatic Centre** will be  
**Monday – Friday** from **2.00 pm to 7.00 pm** and **weekends** from **10.00am to 6.00pm**.

Narromine and Trangie Aquatic Centres will be **closed** on **Christmas Day** and will be **open** from **10.00 am to 6.00 pm** on all **Public Holidays over the summer period**.

### **MAJOR PROJECTS**

Council would like to advise of the following major projects that are currently on public exhibition:

**Inland Rail - Narromine to Narrabri** proposed by Australian Rail Track Corporation Limited. The Proponent has requested the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces to declare the proposal as critical State Significant Infrastructure.

This section of the Inland Rail project consists of approximately 300 km of new single-track rail line, through private and public property in a "greenfield" environment between Narromine and Narrabri.

The State Significant Infrastructure (SSI) application, Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and accompanying documents are on exhibition until Sunday 7 February 2021 and are accessible electronically on the Department's website [www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/project/10211](http://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/project/10211)

**Tomingley Gold** (Alkane Resources Ltd) have submitted a Modification Report and Appendices for Tomingley Gold MOD 5.

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment is aiming to have the Modification on exhibition Wednesday 16 December 2020 to Friday 29 January 2021. Council will hold a hard copy of the application for the exhibition period and it will also be available on the Department's website.
