PUBLIC NOTICE - NORTHERN DRAINAGE STORMWATER PIPE

Narromine Shire Council would like to advise the community that construction works have commenced to improve the stormwater pipeline system. These works are essential to enhance drainage and mitigate potential flooding during heavy rain. Council asks residents to take note of any traffic management measures in place and exercise caution when travelling through the area. The project is expected to be delivered over a six-month period with completion by 30th June 2025, weather permitting. There will be various intermittent road closures during this time with detours and traffic management in place throughout different stages of the project. PENSIONER REBATES

Eligible pensioners in the Narromine Shire may be entitled to receive rebates on their Council rates and charges to help ease the cost of essential services. **Pensioner rebates** of up to \$250.00 for ordinary rates, up to \$87.50 each for water and sewer access charges, and \$50.00 for FOGO (food and organics collection – green bin), are available equating to a maximum rebate of \$475.00 per year for eligible residents. To qualify, residents must hold a valid Pensioner Concession Card or eligible Department of Veterans' Affairs card and be the owner occupier or pay rates at the property you live

in. Pensioners can apply by submitting a completed rebate application form along with proof of eligibility.
